

BACKGROUND

Formerly the Young Investigator Award. This award aims to encourage young investigators to continue their research and to recognize and support their efforts at the beginning of their career.

QUALIFICATIONS

The recipient must have received their PhD or the equivalent terminal degree within the past 10 years and be a current member of SIMB. Their degree must be in Microbiology, Biology, Bioengineering, Biochemistry, or a related discipline, employed in academia, government or private industry and they **MUST** have demonstrated outstanding scientific contributions in the field of biotechnology and or industrial microbiology.

OTHER

The award nomination must be made by two scientists/engineers, both of whom are current members of SIMB and are well acquainted with the nominee. Supporting documentation should include letters from each nominator outlining the reasons why the nominee deserves the award.. The nomination packet should describe in detail the nominee's contributions to the field of biotechnology and/or industrial microbiology, and including a current CV. The nomination package should be submitted to the Awards and Honors Committee (Committee).

The award consists of an appropriately inscribed plaque that is presented to the awardee by the SIMB President at the Annual Meeting. The awardee's travel such as coach airfare, annual meeting registration, special activities, meals and annual meeting hotel expenses will be reimbursed by the SIMB.
